INSTALLATION METHOD

BUTLER/FARMHOUSE



This means the front shows

Pros:

Purely aesthetics. It really makes a statement in your kitchen.

Cons:

The sink itself is more expensive than undermount. Why? Undermount sinks are not glazed on the outside as it is hidden under the benchtop and behind cabinetry.

UNDERMOUNT



This means the benchtop sits on top

Pros:

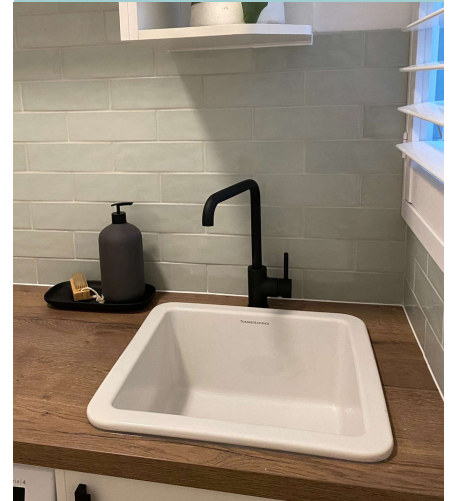
Maximises bench space and has a neat, streamline look.

Also makes wiping scraps off the bench into the sink a breeze.

Cons:

A shelf must be installed under the sink to support the weight of it, which can take up under-sink space. This is also an expensive installation method as the stone edge has to be polished around the edge of the sink.

INSET



This has a rim sitting above the benchtop

Pros:

Perfect for timber or laminate benchtops so the exposed benchtop edge is covered by the rim of the sink.

Also, the cheapest installation method.

Cons:

It makes wiping scraps off the bench hard because the sink rim is in the way. Also takes up more bench space than the undermount method.

COLOUR

GLOSS WHITE



Pure warm white (not bright/ blueish hue).
High gloss smooth shiny finish.

MATTE WHITE



Pure warm white (not bright/ blueish hue).
Flat satin matte finish.

MATTE BLACK



Pure black, no light specs.
Richer black than granite.

CONCRETE LOOK



Matte grey with slight varied grey specs to mimic concrete.

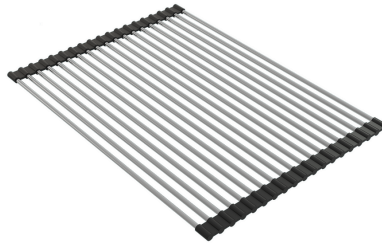
WHAT TO ADD

TAP



Not only functional but is a statement piece!

ROLLER MAT



To sit across the top of your sink and act as a drainer/dryer and hot mat.

SILICONE SINK MAT



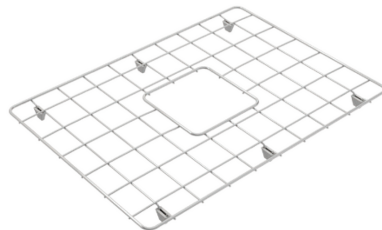
Put in the base of your sink to prevent your glassware or fine China from breaking if accidentally dropped in the sink.

COLANDER



To sit across the top of your sink and act as a strainer/colander.

STAINLESS STEEL GRID



Put in the base of your sink to prevent your glassware or fine China from breaking if accidentally dropped in the sink. Also act as a drainer.

BASKET WASTE



The basket part catches all the scraps making it easier to clean out the waste after washing up.
